WHAT IS YÖS?

What is YÖS? YÖS (Foreign Student Exam) is a university entrance exam used by foreign students who want to study at universities in Turkey for their university applications. The YÖS Exam is not a central exam. It is an important exam for foreign students who want to continue their educational life in Turkey.

Universities in the Republic of Turkey conduct their own YÖS exams.

Who can apply to YÖS?

YÖS Candidates must be in their senior year of high school and must be in graduate status;

- Foreign Nationals
- Those who are Turkish Citizens by birth and then have permission to get out of Turkish citizenship (Blue Card -5901 law)
- While being a foreign national, the Republic of Turkey (T.C.) Naturalized persons

Dual Nationals

- Those who are citizens of the Republic of Turkey and have completed their education in a foreign country
- (It is mandatory that he has studied abroad for the last three years of his education!)
- Students who have completed their education and training in Turkish schools in a foreign country (For example: Western European Open High School Program)
- Those who have the GCE AL exam
- Completely foreign students studying at a high school in Turkey

They are considered to have fulfilled the YÖS Requirements and can participate in the YÖS Exam.

2- What is a Blue Card?

It is the official document given to those who are Turkish citizens by birth and who have lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission to leave, and their subsoys specified in Article 28 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 and indicating that they can benefit from the rights specified in this article.

Which country citizens can apply to YÖS?

All students who meet the requirements of foreign students can apply for the YÖS Exam. Foreign students, Blue card students and students who have completed all of the high school abroad can apply for the YÖS exam and benefit from foreign student quotas.

How many people take the YÖS exam?

Every year, the number of students taking the YÖS exam and the number of foreign students are increasing. An average of 180,000 foreign students are enrolled annually. C.say that they prefer universities. An average of +50,000 students from these students take the YÖS exams.

What is the IÜYÖS, MUYÖS, EGEYÖS, OMU YÖS?

YÖS is not a central exam. since 2011, the YÖS exam has been related to T.C. It is conducted by universities under their own names. For example:

IÜYÖS, MUYÖS,EGEYÖS,AÜYÖS,AYÖS,OMÜYÖS.

Some universities accept applications, especially by accepting the YÖS exam result made by large Public Universities. That is, the YÖS exam result of the State University, which some universities accept without taking their own exam, may be sufficient.

according to Article 14 / f of law No. 6287 published in the Official Gazette No. 28261 dated 11.04.2012, a quota of 35% is allocated for State Universities and 50% for Foundation Universities for international students.

YÖS Exam Applications

YÖS Exam Application conditions, dates and processes are made from the universities' own websites. There are no restrictions on exam applications. Since universities conduct their own YÖS Exams, candidates can apply for and participate in the exams of all universities.

When are YÖS Applications due?

DEC Marching Exam applications are usually made between March and June. Between these months, universities announce their application dates – exam dates and quotas. dec.

YÖS Exam Dates?

YÖS exam dates are determined by universities every year. You can find the YÖS Exam dates for you as every year at this link: Click here for YÖS Exam Dates

When are the YÖS Exam results announced?

YÖS Exam results - Final Admission / Registration results of universities are completed between 3 weeks and 6 weeks after the YÖ DEC Exams are held. Usually the results are obvious through the online system. In some universities, accepted students are published on the official websites of universities as a list.

Where is YÖS made?

YÖS Exams are held primarily within the universities' own campus and in the centers designated at home and abroad. YÖS Exams of various universities in Germany, France, the Netherlands, Russia and 35 different countries are held at a parallel time.

Which Universities Do YÖS?

Many universities in Turkey are recruiting foreign students through the YÖS Exam. The YÖS Exams of some universities are valid in other universities. Istanbul University / Ankara University / Ege University With the results of the YÖS Exam, applications can be made to many universities in Turkey. Of course, universities refer to their own YÖS exam results more. Click here for Universities with YÖS

YÖS Application Fees

YÖS exam application fees are determined by universities every year. The application fees are between 20 USD and 100 USD. dec. Fees may vary depending on the Nationality and Examination Center.

YÖS Exam content

The YÖS Exam usually consists of 80 questions. In these questions, an average of 35 Math Questions – 5 Geometry – 60 IQ questions are asked.

These figures may vary in universities. IQ – General Aptitude Questions are usually asked as 65% in YÖS exams.

Duration of the YÖS Exam

The average time dec in the YÖS exams varies between 90 and 120 minutes. In many universities, it is based on 90 minutes. Students have an average time of 1.12 minutes for a YÖS Exam question.

Basic Scores of the YÖS Exam
